## 1. BACKGROUND

The Caribbean Community Climate Change Centre (CCCCC) has received financing from **Green Climate Fund (GCF)**, toward the cost of the project titled “**Building Capacity for the Regional Approach to Climate Action in the Caribbean: Caribbean Community Climate Change Centre (CCCCC)**” and intends to apply part of the proceeds towards the contracting of an **Environmental and Social Specialist (ESS)**.

The **Environmental and Social Specialist (ESS)** (“the Services”) include but are not limited to:

1. Review and update of the current Environmental and Social Safeguards Policy and Performance Standards of the CCCCC

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2. Review relevant documentation and literature related to the projects/programmes being developed;
  3. Prepare inputs and support the required analyses/studies of environmental issues and/or risks to be addressed in contracts, financing documents, as appropriate
  4. Work closely with the Programme Development Management Unit (PDMU) to ensure findings are meaningfully integrated into project strategies and results framework
  5. Identify complex or sensitive projects that require additional feasibility studies or Environmental Social Impact Assessments (ESIAs)
  6. Assist with the piloting and acceptance of these proposals for funding as it relates to integrating gender equality and the development of environmental and/or social management plan(s) for identifying all risks; and
  7. Ensure that the studies outlined in (5) above are executed and that their findings inform the proposals
  8. Conduct or support the completion of any additional studies that are determined to be needed for the preparation of proposals and final outputs
  9. Any other duties that may be assigned from time to time for the effective and efficient delivery of services within the PDMU.

The Caribbean Community Climate Change Centre now invites eligible Consultants to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

Consultants will be selected in accordance Consultants' Qualifications Selection (CQS), meaning that a consultant will be selected based on experience and competence relevant to the assignment.
